ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Portico Properties, LLC, has applied to the Missouri Public Service Commission for authority to provide water service to an area in or near Warrensburg, Missouri. On July 8, 2008, the Commission issued an order giving notice of the application. In addition, the order noted deficiencies in Portico Properties' filing which must be corrected before the application can be processed, and ordered the Company to supplement its application no later than September 5, 2008.

On September 5, 2008, Portico Properties requested an extension of time, to October 3, 2008, to cure the deficiencies of its application. The Company stated that it seeks additional time to confirm that the interests of Portico Properties are adequately protected to ensure that, should Portico Properties withdraw its application and charge residents based upon their usage without additional service, administrative, or other fees, it would be in good standing with the Public Service Commission. Portico Properties further stated that, in the alternative, if it cannot confirm that under such a scenario it would be in good standing with the Commission, it would cure the deficiencies of its application as promptly as possible.

The Commission has considered Portico Properties' request and finds it reasonable to extend the filing date for the Company to supplement its application.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Portico Properties, LLC's Application to Extend Date to Cure Deficiencies is granted.
2. Portico Properties, LLC, shall supplement its application no later than October 3, 2008.
3. The filing date for the Commission Staff's recommendation in this case is suspended pending further order of the Commission.
4. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
