ORDER ESTABLISHING AN EXPEDITED RESPONSE DEADLINE

On July 11, 2012, Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC”) requested expedited approval of its tariffs to occur immediately after the acquisition of the assets for which the Commission has granted it a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity. MAWC represents that the Commission’s Staff does not oppose its motion. Because MAWC wishes expedited approval of its tariffs, the Commission will set an expedited deadline for responses.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to Missouri-American Water Company’s request for expedited approval of its tariffs shall file their response no later than July 13, 2012.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
