**ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE  
STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

On August 15, 2014, The Tranquility Group, LLC d/b/a Branson Cedars Resort filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) requesting that the Commission grant it a certificate of convenience and necessity to own, operate, control, manage and maintain water systems in Taney County, Missouri. On September 16, 2014, the Commission issued an order which required Staff to file a recommendation regarding the application no later than October 14, 2014. On September 18, 2014, Staff filed a request for an extension of time until November 14, 2014 to file its recommendation due to the press of other business. Ten days have elapsed and no parties have objected to Staff’s motion. The Commission finds the request reasonable and will grant it.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The deadline for Staff to file its recommendation regarding this matter is extended until no later than November 14, 2014.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
