On August 25, 2005, Benjamin D. Pugh filed a complaint against Folsom Ridge, LLC, owning and controlling the Big Island Homeowners Association. On August 29, the Commission issued a notice informing Folsom Ridge of the complaint and directing it to file an answer by September 29. On September 29, Folsom Ridge filed a request for mediation, indicating its willingness to enter into third party mediation. Before proceeding further, the Commission will allow the complainant an opportunity to indicate whether he is also willing to enter into mediation regarding the complaint.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Benjamin D. Pugh shall, no later than October 14, 2005, file a response to Folsom Ridge's request for voluntary mediation, indicating whether he is willing to enter into such mediation. 2. That the time allowed for Folsom Ridge to file an answer to the complaint is

tolled until the complainant has responded to the offer to mediate.

3. That this order shall become effective on October 4, 2005.
