STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation respectfully states:

1. Susan D. Jaeger (Complainant) filed a formal complaint against Joe Hybl (Respondent) on June 27, 2006 because her water service had been discontinued.

A consent order was entered in Warren County Circuit Court on August 29, 2006.
As a part of that consent order, Respondent agreed to resume water service to Complainant.

3. On September 14, 2006, Staff confirmed that Complainant's water service had been restored.

4. As part of the August 29, 2006 consent order, Respondent agreed to apply for certificates of convenience and necessity to operate water and sewer facilities. Those applications were filed on November 29, 2006 in the name of Oakview Estates Water & Sewer, LLC and have been consolidated into Case No. WA-2007-0201. The applications are currently pending.

5. Because Staff has confirmed that Complainant's water service has been restored and because certificate applications have been filed, Staff recommends that this case may be closed.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order closing Case No. WC-2006-0550.
