## **ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On June 28, 2006, Mark S. Liesenfeld filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission. Mr. Liesenfeld claims that Mr. Hybl discontinued his water service without notice, and forced him to install a private well. Mr. Hybl failed to timely respond to the complaint.

As directed, the Commission's Staff filed a report on September 8. Staff reported that under the terms of a consent order from the Circuit Court of Warren County, Mr. Hybl agreed to reconnect Mr. Liesenfeld, as well as other disconnected customers. Also, Staff's report indicates that the Commission has no authority to order Mr. Hybl to pay money damages. In light of Staff's report, there appear to be no issues for the Commission to resolve in this case.<sup>1</sup> The Commission will direct its Staff to state whether the Commission should or should not dismiss the complaint.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission, and any other party who wishes to do so, shall

file a pleading as directed above no later than October 27, 2006.

- 2. Any party may respond to Staff's pleading no later than November 6, 2006.
- 3. This order shall become effective on September 27, 2006.
