**ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL TIME**

On August 28, 2006, the Staff of the Commission filed a complaint against the above-listed respondents, claiming that Respondents are providing water without the requisite Commission authority. The Commission gave Respondents notice of the complaint on August 30.

On October 3, Respondents filed a Request for Additional Time. Respondents state that they are in the process of applying for a certificate of convenience and necessity, but need additional time to get more information. Respondents ask for an extension of time until October 30 to file an answer.

The Commission has reviewed Respondent's motion, finds it reasonable, and will grant it.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Request for Additional Time filed by Joe Hybl, Oakview Estates Homeowners Association, Jack Hybl, and James Scott Hybl is granted.
2. The above-named respondents shall answer the complaint filed by the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission no later than October 30, 2006.
3. This order shall become effective on October 4, 2006.
