In an effort to clarify the Arbitrator's decision with regard to single/multiple points of interconnection, the Arbitrator will direct that CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC file a pleading setting out its access line-to-trunk ratio for each of its exchanges. In other words, if there are a certain number of access lines in an exchange, how does CenturyTel determine how many trunks are needed to carry traffic out of that exchange?

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC shall file, no later than June 20, 2006, a pleading as described in the body of this order.
2. This order shall become effective on June 9, 2006.
