In an effort to clarify the Arbitrator's decision with regard to single/multiple points of interconnection, the Arbitrator issued an order directing that CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC file a pleading setting out its access line-to-trunk ratio for each of its exchanges.

On June 9, 2006, Socket Telecom, LLC filed a motion for reconsideration of the Arbitrator's order. Socket argued that the order may prompt CenturyTel to file information that is self-serving and not subject to scrutiny. After consulting with Advisory Staff, the Arbitrator finds Socket's arguments compelling and will grant the requested relief.

The Arbitrator realizes that CenturyTel was not afforded an opportunity to respond to Socket's motion. However, the Arbitrator reasons that CenturyTel would only oppose the motion if such opposition would be to CenturyTel's benefit. The Arbitrator must then conclude that CenturyTel's opposition to the motion means that CenturyTel would prefer to supply the additional information, which would also be to CenturyTel's benefit. If this were the case, then Socket's arguments would be supported by CenturyTel's opposition to Socket's motion.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Order Directing Filing, issued by the Arbitrator on June 9, 2006, is withdrawn and that CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC need not file a pleading in compliance with that order.

2. This order shall become effective on June 14, 2006.
