On March 22, 2007, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an *Order Authorizing Sale of Stock*. In that order, the Commission directed certain parties to provide the Staff of the Commission with copies of all closing journal entries within sixty days of the final closing. The final closing was April 1, 2007. The journal entries to Staff would therefore have been due by June 1.

2. The Staff of the Commission shall file a notice when it receives copies of the closing journal entries.
