**ORDER OPENING A CASE TO CONSIDER THE  
AMOUNT OF THE UNIVERSAL SERVICE FUND ASSESSMENT**

On May 6, 2014, the Commission's Staff filed a Motion to Alter Assessment. Staff states that the Commission shall establish the level of funding for the Missouri Universal Service Fund. Staff asks that the Commission open a file in which Staff can place its memorandum concerning this funding, and in which the Commission can receive comments from interested persons. The Commission will do so.

This file shall serve as a repository for documents and comments. Using this file, anyone with an interest in this matter may view documents and may submit any pertinent responsive comments or documents. As this is not a contested case, anyone may file a comment without counsel and without *ex parte* constraints (arising from this matter). Intervention requests are not necessary to submit comments or view documents.

The public is welcome to submit comments by forwarding electronic communications through the Commission's electronic filing and information system (EFIS) or by mailing written comments.
