## **ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER**

On June 15, 2006, MCI Communications Services, Inc., d/b/a Verizon Business Services, filed its Application seeking review and reversal of the decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator, NeuStar, Inc., to withhold a block of 2,000 contiguous numbers that Verizon asserts it needs to provide service to a new customer in the 314 NPA.

On the same date, Verizon filed a Motion for Protective Order. Verizon states that certain information attached to its application is highly confidential and should not be made public.

Upon review of the motion, the Commission finds that there is a need to protect confidential information and the request for a protective order is reasonable. The Commission has previously recognized the need to protect confidential information, and the issuance of protective orders has helped to minimize disputes in past cases. The Commission will adopt its standard protective order for this case.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion for Protective Order filed by MCI Communications Services,

Inc., d/b/a Verizon Business Services, is granted and the protective order attached hereto as Attachment A is adopted.

2. This order shall become effective on June 16, 2006.
