ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE SURREBUTTAL TESTIMONY

The Commission has adopted a procedural schedule for this case that, among other things, sets February 15, 2007, as the filing date for the parties' surrebuttal testimony. On February 14, 2007, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a motion to enlarge this time by one day, until February 16, 2007. In support of its request, Public Counsel cited inclement winter weather conditions which have delayed completion and preparation of its testimony. Public Counsel submitted that a one-day extension will not prejudice any party.

The Commission has considered Public Counsel's request and finds that it is reasonable to grant the requested extension.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The filing date for surrebuttal testimony is extended to February 16, 2007.

2. This order shall become effective on February 14, 2007.
