ORDER CLARIFYING ORDER
ACKNOWLEDGING RECEIPT OF STATUS REPORT

On January 25, 2008, the Commission issued an order acknowledging receipt of status report filed by the Missouri Independent Telephone Company Group companies ("MITG"). The Commission's Order directed the MITG companies to notify the Commission when the U.S. Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit's stay of the FCC's intermodal LNP rules is lifted. On February 8, 2008, the MITG companies filed a request asking the Commission to clarify the above-referenced directive.

MITG stated that they are not parties to the D.C. Circuit proceedings and do not receive notice of activities in that case. Furthermore, the requirement to monitor the D.C. Circuit docket will impose unnecessary expenditures upon MITG companies and their counsel. MITG also stated that if they became aware of the stay being lifted, they would report the same to the Commission. The Commission finds it is

reasonable for MITG to notify the Commission if they become aware of the lifting of the stay. The Commission will clarify the order accordingly.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Missouri Independent Telephone Company Group companies Request for Clarification or Modification is granted.

2. The Missouri Independent Telephone Company Group companies shall notify this Commission if they become aware that the D.C. Circuit Court of Appeals' stay of the local number portability rules has been lifted.

3. This order shall become effective on March 26, 2008.

4. This case may be closed on March 27, 2008.
