**REQUEST FOR COMMISSION ORDER MODIFYING ORDER BY DEEMING
CONDITION A.2. REQUIRING REPORTING OF MONTHLY MASTER METER AND
CUSTOMER METER READINGS TO STAFF AS COMPLETED AND DISCONTINUE
REQUIRED REPORTING**

COME NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), through counsel, submits its Request For Commission Order Modifying Order By Deeming Condition A.2. Requiring Reporting Of Monthly Master Meter And Customer Meter Readings To Staff As Completed and Discontinue Required Reporting, and states:

1. On July 25, 2008, the Commission issued its *Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement, Adopting its Conditions and Requiring Compliance Therewith, and Dismissing Gordon Burnam* (Approval Order). This Approval Order approved the Stipulation and Agreement submitted on July 11, 2008, by Staff, Suburban Water and Sewer Company, Inc. (Suburban), and the Office of the Public Counsel.

2. On February 9, 2009, Staff submitted its Final Report Regarding Suburban's Completion of Terms to inform the Commission primarily that Suburban has replaced its standpipe as required by the Approval Order. In addition, Staff noted that Suburban provided monthly reports regarding master meter and customer meter readings for Staff to review for indications of water leaks pursuant to Stipulation and Agreement, condition A.2. at page 4. Staff

reported that Suburban established a meter reading process which enabled Suburban, with Staff's assistance, to use the collected data to monitor and identify water leakage in the system. Therefore, the basis underlying this meter reporting condition had been met.

3. Now, to make sure the record is clear in this case, Staff respectfully requests that the Approval Order be modified to specifically discontinue the required reporting of the master meter and customer meter readings.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully requests the *Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement, Adopting its Conditions and Requiring Compliance Therewith, and Dismissing Gordon Burnam* be modified by order which specifically discontinues the reporting of the master meter and customer meter readings as required by condition A.2. in the Stipulation and Agreement.
