ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On August 13, 2004, Focal Communications Corporation of Missouri and Broadwing Communications, LLC, applied for permission to move Focal's assets and customers to Broadwing. On October 28, the Commission approved the sale in Case No. TA-2005-0045.

In its October 28 order, the Commission ordered Broadwing to file tariffs in a separate case before offering services under its basic local exchange certificate of service authority. On March 1, Broadwing filed tariff sheets bearing an effective date of April 15, 2005.

On April 8, the Commission approved them to become effective April 15. One of the tariffs the Commission approved was a tariff to allow Broadwing to provide local, message toll and long-distance end-user communications services. Broadwing named that tariff P.S.C. MO Tariff No. 1. The Commission assigned that Tariff No. YC-2005-0668.

Broadwing had previously filed a Tariff No. 1 to serve interexchange customers. The Commission assigned that Tariff No. JX-2004-0199. Currently, Broadwing has two Missouri No. 1 tariffs.

The Commission will order Broadwing to file new tariff sheets to provide local, message toll and long-distance end-user communications services. Those new tariff sheets shall bear a title that will easily distinguish that tariff from Tariff No. JX-2004-0199.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Broadwing Communications, LLC shall file new tariff sheets to provide local, message toll and long-distance end-user communications services that have a title that will easily distinguish that tariff from its interexchange tariff, Tariff JX-2004-0199.
- 2. That Broadwing Communications, LLC shall file the sheets described in paragraph 1 no later than May 13, 2005.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on April 13, 2005.
