ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO SUBMIT ENGINEERING STUDY

In an order issued October 26, 2006, the Commission granted Lake Region Water & Sewer Company a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide water and sewer services to an expanded service area in a portion of Camden County, Missouri. The stipulation and agreement that was the basis of the Commission's order required Lake Region to prepare and submit an engineering study to determine the long-term needs of the expanded water and sewer system. That study was to be completed within six months.

On September 10, 2007, Lake Region filed a motion requesting additional time to submit the required engineering study. The motion explains that because it is located in a resort area, Lake Region's water and sewer system is not heavily used during the winter months. In order to obtain relevant data about peak usage of the system during the summer months, Lake Region had to delay conducting the engineering study until it could include the summer months. The data has now been collected, and Lake Region anticipates submitting the engineering study by November 30, 2007.

The Commission's Staff filed a response to Lake Region's motion for extension of time on September 27. Staff indicates that it finds Lake Region's request reasonable and does not oppose the granting of more time to submit the engineering study.

Based on the recommendation of its Staff, the Commission will allow Lake Region more time to prepare and submit its engineering study.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Lake Region Water and Sewer Company's Motion to Extend Time Within Which to Submit Engineering Study is granted.

2. Lake Region Water and Sewer Company shall submit the engineering study required by the approved stipulation and agreement no later than November 30, 2007

- 3. This order shall become effective on September 28, 2007.
- 4. This case shall be closed on September 29, 2007.
