## ORDER CANCELING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

Highway H Utilities, Inc. has applied to the Commission for authority to construct and operate water and sewer systems in an expanded service area in Pulaski County. Staff filed a recommendation advising the Commission to grant the requested service authority and to establish the initial rates the company may charge to customers in the new service area. Public Counsel initially disagreed with a portion of Staff's recommendation, so the Commission scheduled a prehearing conference for June 16, 2009, to facilitate discussion among the parties leading to either an agreed upon resolution, or the establishment of a procedural schedule.

On June 9, Public Counsel filed an amended response to Staff's recommendation in which it withdraws its previous objection to Staff's recommendation. Since there is no longer any disagreement among the parties, there is no need for a prehearing conference. As a result, the Commission will cancel the prehearing conference.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The prehearing conference scheduled for June 16, 2009, is cancelled.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
