On April 28, 2005, Lockheed Martin Global Telecommunications Services, Inc. (Lockheed), a competitive telecommunications company, filed its Surrender of Certificate of Service Authority. The Commission issued an Order on April 29, 2005 directing Staff to file a recommendation no later than May 27, 2005.

Lockheed was granted a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications service on July 17, 2002 in Case No. TA-2002-286. According to Lockheed's pleading, the company has no customers in Missouri so cancellation of its certificate of service authority is not detrimental to the public interest. The Staff has no objection to the request for cancellation and recommends that the Commission issue an order to cancel Lockheed's certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications service and accompanying tariff, MO P.S.C. Tariff No. 1. The Staff is unaware of any other filing which affects or which would be affected by this proposal.

The Company is not delinquent in filing an annual report and paying the PSC assessment. The Company is delinquent. Staff recommends the Commission grant the requested relief/action on the condition the applicant corrects the delinquency. The applicant should be instructed to make the appropriate filing in this case after it has corrected the delinquency.
