Dear Commissioners:

On February 28, 2009, The Missouri Public Service Commission issued to Charter Communications Entertainment I, LLC, d/b/a Charter Communications, ("Charter") a Notice of Change, whereby the Commission expanded Charter's Video Service Authorization to include a number of communities, including the Village of Vinita Terrace, Missouri.

Recently, Charter was informed by the City of Vinita Park, Missouri ("City") that the Village of Vinita Terrace has been officially consolidated into the City, which is located in St. Louis County, Missouri. Due to the consolidation, the Village of Vinita Terrace has ceased to be an incorporated municipality.

Pursuant to §67.2685, Charter is advising the Commission that it seeks to remove the Village of Vinita Terrace, Missouri from its Video Service Authorization list under Case Number KA-2009-0286. Charter has a Video Service Authorization for the City of Vinita Park, which was issued by the Commission on March 19, 2009 under Case Number KA-2009-0307. Charter will continue to provide video services to subscribers who were previously located in the former jurisdiction of Vinita Terrace, as they now officially reside in the City of Vinita Park.
