PROGRESS REPORT

COMES NOW Calvey Brook Water, Inc. (hereinafter "Applicant"), in response to the Order Directing Filing of Progress Report Regarding Tariffs, effective on October 5, 2004, issued by the Missouri Public Service Commission (hereinafter "Commission") and states as follows:

1. Applicant has completed the construction of the water system, however, because the construction of the sewer system has not been completed at this time, the water system cannot be placed in operation pursuant to DNR rules and regulations.


2. Because the entire system (water and sewer) cannot be placed in operation, no residential construction has begun in the Service Area meaning that no customers of Applicant exist at this point in time.

3. Applicant is in the process of preparing a complete tariff required to implement the certificate of convenience and necessity granted by the Commission on or about May 25, 2004 and expects that the tariff will be filed no later than November 15, 2004.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission accept the above explanation and the filing of the complete tariff on or before November 15, 2004
