On January 14, 2009, ¹ pursuant to Section 393.170, RSMo 2000, and Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-2.060, 4 CSR 240-3.305, and 4 CSR 240-3.600, Dale Whiteside and Whiteside Hidden Acres, L.L.C, (hereafter "Applicant") filed two applications (as captioned in the style of these cases above) with the Missouri Public Service Commission. ² Applicant requests that the Commission grant it authority to own, operate, control, manage, improve and maintain a water system for the public in Hickory County, Missouri.

On May 21, Staff filed its Recommendation, in which it recommends that the Commission grant the certificate with certain conditions. On June 1, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a request for an extension of time to respond to the Staff Recommendation. OPC states that it believes that a resolution to the issues in this case will be achieved if OPC is granted an extension of time until June 8 to respond to the Staff Recommendation. OPC further states that neither Staff nor Applicant objects to OPC's request.

² On March 24, the Commission granted leave to Whiteside Hidden Acres, L.L.C., to file an amended application. The sole applicant is now Whiteside Hidden Acres, L.L.C. Also, Whiteside Hidden Acres, L.L.C. voluntarily dismissed its application for a certificate to provide sewer service.

In light of a lack of objection to OPC's request, the Commission will grant it.
