On December 8, 2009, Interface Security Systems, L.L.C. filed an Application with the Missouri Public Service Commission for registration to offer and provide interconnected voice over Internet protocol in unspecified areas in Missouri. The Application filed on December 8, 2009, will be rejected.

The Application filed by Interface Security Systems, L.L.C. did not contain a signature, or the signer's street address, telephone number, facsimile number and electronic e-mail address. The application also failed to contain a completed certificate of service. Further, the affidavit attached to the application failed to provide the exchanges in which the company proposes to provide VoIP service, pursuant to §392.550.3(2), RSMo, Cum. Supp. 2008.

On December 8, 2009, the Commission issued a Notice of Deficiency allowing the company to correct the deficiencies by December 18. No response was filed. Thus, the Application is rejected by the Commission.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Application filed by Interface Security Systems, L.L.C. on December 8, 2009, is rejected.

2. This case may be closed.
3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
