**ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

On March 23, 2006, the Commission issued its Arbitration Order. The order required the parties to file an interconnection agreement no later than April 22, 2006. Additionally, the Staff of the Commission was directed to file a Memorandum and Recommendation advising the Commission that it has reviewed the interconnection agreement and determined whether it complies with the Arbitration Order and applicable statutes no later than May 2, 2006. Because of the press of other matters, Petitioners<sup>1</sup> and T-Mobile USA, Inc. filed, on April 21, 2006, a joint motion for an extension of time to file their interconnection agreement. The applicants stated that they would file the agreement no later than May 22, 2006. However, and for the same reason, Movants now request that the time for filing an interconnection agreement be extended to June 22, 2006.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Joint Motion for Extension of Time to File Interconnection Agreement is granted.
2. The Petitioners and T-Mobile, USA, Inc. shall file, no later than June 22, 2006, an interconnection agreement as described in the Arbitration Order issued on March 23, 2006.
3. The Staff of the Commission shall file its memorandum recommending approval or rejection of the interconnection agreement 30 days after the interconnection agreement is filed with the Commission.
4. This order shall become effective on May 22, 2006.
