NOTICE OF CLARIFICATION

Issue Date: July 18, 2011

On July 5, 2011, the Commission issued a notice of deficiency informing Panasonic of North America that its request for registration to provide interconnected voice over Internet protocol (IVoIP) service was deficient. The Commission further stated in its notice that Panasonic may cure its deficiency no later than July 20, 2011.

Panasonic filed a letter requesting that the Commission clarify its notice to state whether section 392.550, RSMo, applied to nomadic IVoIP providers, such as Panasonic, providing resold VoIP service. And, if the statute applies, Panasonic requested the Commission to state how such a carrier might comply with the request to list all exchanges in which it seeks to provide service.

After reviewing the additional information provided by Panasonic, the Commission determines that the application for registration is not deficient. Because of

the difficulty in determining the exchanges for a nomadic provider of IVoIP services, the request for statewide registration will be sufficient.¹
