ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, ESTABLISHING TIME FOR FILING
REQUESTS TO INTERVENE, ESTABLISHING TIME FOR FILING
RECOMMENDATIONS, AND GRANTING MOTION FOR EXPEDITED
TREATMENT

This order directs that notice of this case be sent to all certificated interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications companies in the state of Missouri and to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator. The order also establishes dates for the filing of requests to intervene, for the filing of recommendations, and granting the motion for expedited treatment.

On February 1, 2007, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri, filed an application and Motion for Expedited Treatment under 47 C.F.R. 52.15(g)(3)(iv) requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission review and reverse a decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA), NeuStar, Inc., to withhold certain numbering resources from AT&T Missouri. The numbering resources AT&T Missouri requested consist of a single thousands-block within the NPA-NXX of 573-705, or other suitable NXX, and within the XXXX range from 1000 through 1999 to service the

needs of Botkin Lumber Company Inc. in Farmington, Missouri. The numbering resources are required in order to meet Botkin's expansion needs in a manner consistent with its recent order for the installation of 1000 Direct Inward Dial numbers.

The Commission concludes that good cause has been shown pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(16). The Commission finds that proper persons should be allowed to file a request for intervention or a motion for hearing. Therefore, the Commission will set a time for interventions as directed below. The Commission will also direct its Data Center to send a copy of this order to each certificated interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications company in Missouri. In addition, the Data Center shall send a copy of this order to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator, NeuStar, Inc.

The Commission will also direct its Staff to file a recommendation and will establish a date by which any other party wishing to respond must file a recommendation.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri's Motion for Expedited Treatment, is granted.
2. The Data Center shall send a copy of this order to each certificated interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications company in Missouri and to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator, NeuStar, Inc.
3. Any party wishing to intervene or to request a hearing shall do so by filing an appropriate pleading no later than February 16, 2007, with:

4. Any other party that wishes to file a recommendation regarding the application of AT&T Missouri, shall do so no later than February 16, 2007, and shall file its recommendation simultaneously with its application to intervene.

5. The Staff of the Commission shall file a recommendation regarding the application of AT&T Missouri, no later than February 16, 2007, or as soon as possible thereafter.

6. This order shall become effective February 6, 2007.
