MOTION TO RE-DESIGNATE SCHEDULE AND MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Service Commission and for its motion states:

1. On February 27, 2007, the Staff filed the testimony of Staff witness Adam McKinnie. Schedule 2 to Mr. McKinnie's testimony consists of pages from the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG). Embarq had provided the LERG pages to Staff. Embarq had not designated the pages as confidential or proprietary.

2. After the Staff had filed Mr. McKinnie's testimony, Embarq contacted the Staff and stated that Embarq should have designated the LERG pages as proprietary. Embarq states that the LERG information is a product of its subscription to Telcordia Technologies and is the proprietary information of Telcordia.

WHEREFORE, the Staff requests the Commission to expeditiously designate Schedule 2 of Mr. McKinnie's testimony as proprietary.
