**ORDER OVERTURNING NORTH AMERICAN
NUMBERING PLAN ADMINISTRATOR'S DECISION**

On November 9, 2007, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri filed an application and Motion for Expedited Treatment requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission review and reverse a decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA), NeuStar, Inc., of AT&T Missouri's application to obtain a single block of one thousand numbers within the NPA-NXX of 636-717 in the Fenton rate center, to meet the needs of Butler Chevrolet.

On November 19, 2007, the Staff of the Commission filed its Staff Recommendation. No other applications to intervene, requests for hearing, or recommendations have been filed. Staff recommended the Commission grant AT&T Missouri's request for a single block of one thousand numbers within the NPA-NXX of 636-717 in the Fenton rate center, and within any of the XXXX ranges of 3000-3999, 4000-

4999, 5000-5999, 7000-7999, 8000-8999 or 9000-9999 from which 100 sequential telephone numbers can be drawn.

The Commission has the authority to overturn NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources from a carrier pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §52.15(g)(4), which states in part, "The state commission also may overturn the NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources from the carrier based on its determination that the carrier has demonstrated a verifiable need for numbering resources and has exhausted all other available remedies."

Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that AT&T Missouri has demonstrated a verifiable need for numbering resources and has exhausted all other available remedies. The Commission overturns NANPA's decision and approves AT&T Missouri's requests for one block of thousand telephone numbers as listed above.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The North American Numbering Plan Administrator's decision to withhold numbering resources from Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri is overturned.
2. AT&T Missouri's request to receive a single block of one thousand numbers within the NPA-NXX of 636-717 in the Fenton rate center, and within any of the XXXX ranges of 3000-3999, 4000-4999, 5000-5999, 7000-7999, 8000-8999 or 9000-9999 from which 100 sequential telephone numbers can be drawn, is granted.
3. This order shall become effective on November 20, 2007.

4. This case may be closed on November 21, 2007.
