ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR STAFF TO FILE RECOMMENDATION

On November 20, 2008, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Missouri, filed an Application and Motion for Expedited Treatment seeking the Missouri Public Service Commission review and reverse a decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA), NeuStar, Inc., to withhold certain numbering resources from AT&T Missouri. The Commission directed its Staff to file a recommendation regarding the application by December 5, 2008.

On December 5, Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to extend the time allowed for Staff to file its recommendation. Staff explains that additional information has been requested and Staff will need additional time to analyze the information. For that reason, Staff asks for additional time to file its recommendation.

Staff's motion is reasonable and the Commission will grant Staff the additional time it needs to file its recommendation.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Staff's Request for Extension to File Recommendation is granted.

2. Staff shall file its recommendation regarding Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri's application for review and reverse a decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator no later than December 12, 2008.

3. This order shall become effective on December 8, 2008.
