## NOTICE OF DEFICIENCY

On March 11, 2014, Reflective Group, LLC, filed an application for registration to provide statewide interconnected voice over Internet protocol service. Reflective Group's application was not complete in that the application was not signed by a person identified as an attorney licensed to practice law in Missouri. The application was signed by Robert C. Levy who identifies himself as Reflective Group's lawyer, but the application does not include Mr. Levy's Missouri Bar Number, nor is Mr. Levy listed as a member of the Missouri Bar on the Missouri Bar's website.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(2) requires that pleadings filed with the Commission be signed by at least one attorney of record authorized to practice law in Missouri. Reflective Group's pleading does not comply with that requirement and for that reason is deficient. The Commission will not take action on this application until the deficiency is corrected.

The Commission will leave this file open until April 1, 2014, to allow Reflective Group to correct the deficiency. If the application is not corrected by that time, the Commission will reject the application and close the file.
