PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND NOTICE OF HEARING

The Commission is setting forth the procedural schedule and giving notice of a hearing on the merits, in accordance with the parties' *Joint Proposed Procedural Schedule*.¹ Mr. Dzurinskiy's motion for mediation is still pending, because the Commission has reserved ruling on that motion. The Commission encourages the parties to continue their discussions on matters procedural and substantive.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than November 1, 2010, the parties shall file a joint list of issues, list of witnesses, and order of cross-examination.

2. On November 15, 2010, at 10:00 a.m., the regulatory law judge assigned to this case will convene a hearing on the merits of the complaint. The hearing will be at the Commission's St. Louis area office, in Room 105, Wainwright Building, 111 North 7th Street, St. Louis, MO 63101. The Commission has scheduled one day for the hearing.
