NOTICE ON SCHEDULES ATTACHED TO TESTIMONY

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), by and through the undersigned counsel, and for its *Notice on Schedules Attached to Testimony* respectfully states:

1. Staff was to file its surrebuttal in this matter today, December 2, 2020.
2. However, due to technical difficulties involving Adobe Acrobat, Staff is unable to open and file Schedules PC-s1 and PC-s2 in EFIS. Both schedules are referenced in Staff witness Peter Chari’s surrebuttal.
3. Staff is working on remedying the technical difficulties involving Adobe Acrobat. However, at this time, it is unlikely that Staff will be able to file the above referenced schedules in time to comply with the Commission-ordered procedural schedule. Staff intends to file the schedules as soon as the technical difficulties are remedied.
4. These technical difficulties present good cause for the Commission to grant Staff leave to late-file Schedules PC-s1 and PC-s2, per Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.050(3)(B).

WHEREFORE, Staff prays that the Commission accept its *Notice*, and grant Staff the time necessary to remedy these technical difficulties in order to file Schedules PC-s1 and PC-s2 in order to complete Staff witness Peter Chari’s surrebuttal.
