On February 23, 2021, Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC), on behalf of all the parties, filed a motion requesting to suspend the procedural schedule including the hearing that is set to begin at 2:00 p.m., February 24, 2021. MAWC relates that the parties have reached a global settlement in principle and wish to have the procedural schedule suspended while they put the terms in writing and file with the Commission. The Commission will grant the request.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The procedural schedule, including the evidentiary hearing set to begin on February 24, 2021, at 2:00 p.m., are suspended until further order of the Commission.
2. The parties are directed to file either a stipulation and agreement resolving the contested issues or a status report no later than February 26, 2021.
3. This order shall become effective when issued.
