**ORDER DIRECTING FILING OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE
AND NOTICE OF THE GRANT OF INTERVENTION REQUESTS**

On June 30, 2020, Missouri-American Water Company (Missouri-American) filed tariff sheets designed to implement a general rate increase for water and sewer services. The Commission directed notice and set a deadline of July 22, 2020, for intervention applications.

Timely applications to intervene were filed by Triumph Foods, LLC, The Empire District Electric Company, Public Water Supply District No. 2 of Andrew County, Consumers Council of Missouri, Sunnydale Properties, Municipal League of Metro St. Louis, and Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers.¹ Additionally, on July 23, 2020, the City of Riverside, Missouri, filed a request to intervene out of time.

On August 3, 2020, the parties met in a prehearing conference via video and telephone. There were no objections to any of the pending applications to intervene and the Regulatory Law Judge granted the pending intervention requests.

The parties also met to discuss a proposed procedural schedule. The parties are directed to file their proposed procedural schedule as set out below.

¹ Midwest Energy Consumers Group and the City of St. Joseph, Missouri, also filed timely applications to intervene which were granted on July 20, 2020.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The applications to intervene of Triumph Foods, LLC, The Empire District Electric Company, Public Water Supply District No. 2 of Andrew County, Consumers Council of Missouri, Sunnydale Properties, Municipal League of Metro St. Louis, Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, and the City of Riverside, Missouri are granted.

2. No later than August 13, 2020, the parties shall jointly, or separately, file a proposed procedural schedule.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
