ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

On June 30, 2020, Missouri-American Water Company (Missouri-American) filed tariff sheets designed to implement a general rate increase for water and sewer services. The Commission directed notice and set a deadline for intervention applications.

Applications to intervene were filed by Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG) and the City of St. Joseph, Missouri, on July 6, 2020, and July 7, 2020, respectively. MECG and the City of St. Joseph, Missouri, each stated they have interests that are different than the interest of the general public. MECG and the City of St. Joseph, Missouri, have not yet taken positions but stated that their participation will assist the Commission in developing a full record.

More than ten days have passed since the applications were filed and no one has responded. After considering the unopposed applications to intervene, the Commission finds that MECG and the City of St. Joseph, Missouri, have interests which are different from that of the general public and allowing these entities to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The application to intervene of the MECG is granted.
- 2. The application to intervene of the City of St. Joseph, Missouri, is granted.
- 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
