Objections to discovery request must be made in writing and served upon the requesting party within five (5) calendar days of the date the discovery was issued or explain the inability to provide the requested information within ten (10) days and state the date on which the requested information will be provided. If the day a discovery response or objection is due falls upon a weekend or holiday, then the response or objection is due the next business day.
- 4. All discovery requests served on or after the date Rebuttal Testimony is due on October 13, 2017, shall be responded to within five (5) business days. Objections to discovery requests must be made in writing and served upon the requesting party within three (3) business days or explain the inability to provide the requested information within

five (5) days and state the date on which the requested information will be provided. If the day a discovery response or objection is due falls upon a weekend or holiday, then the response or objection is due the next business day.
