**ORDER SCHEDULING LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING
AND DIRECTING NOTICE**

On June 13, 2022, Argyle Estates Water Supply (Argyle Estates) filed a letter initiating a staff assisted rate case under Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-10.075. Subsection 6 of the rule requires a local public hearing to occur no later than 60 days after the opening of the case unless all parties agree that a local public hearing is not necessary. The Commission will schedule a local public hearing in compliance with the Commission Rule. The Commission will hold the hearing via video and telephone conference, and will direct written comments to be submitted to the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System (EFIS).

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. A public hearing is scheduled to begin at **6:00 p.m.** on **July 21, 2022**, via the internet-based video and teleconferencing service, WebEx. At the time of the hearing dial 1-855-718-6621 and enter the Access Code/Password

2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make an informal presentation and conduct a question-and-answer session for the public at the beginning of the local public hearing. Comments to the Commission from the public will begin at the conclusion of the question and answer session.

3. Argyle Estates, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, and the Office of the Public Counsel shall make a representative available to address substantive issues during the question-and-answer sessions. Any other party may also choose to have a representative present.

4. No later than ten days before the local public hearing, Argyle Estates shall provide notice of the hearing to each of its customers.

5. Any person may comment at the hearing. To facilitate an orderly presentation that can be preserved for the record, members of the public who wish to participate in the hearing shall register by sending their first and last name, phone number, and email address to watersewercomments@psc.mo.gov, or by calling (800) 392-4211 no later than 5:00 p.m. the day before the hearing, July 20, 2022.

6. A live audio web stream at the Commission's website, www.psc.mo.gov, will provide audio of the hearing. Those who do not intend to participate in the hearing should listen via the web stream.

7. Comments may also be submitted to the Commission in writing. When submitting comments please reference File No. WR-2022-0345. Submit comments:
