**ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING**

On November 4, 2014, Kimberling City Water Company (“KCWC”) asked that the Commission approve its agreement with the Upper White River Basin Foundation, Inc., (“UWRB”). That agreement would allow KCWC to sell its assets to UWRB.

On December 5, 2014, the Office of the Public Counsel requested a local public hearing (“hearing”). KCWC responded on December 8, 2014. KCWC did not consent to a hearing, but stated that if the Commission wished to hold a hearing, that it should do so promptly.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.110(1) requires the Commission to set the time and place for hearings and serve notice as required by law. Section 536.067(4), RSMo 2000, and Section 386.390.5, RSMo 2000, require at least ten days’ notice be given prior to a hearing.

In complying with its statutory mandate, the Commission will set the date for a local public hearing to be held on January 5, 2015.

## **THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission gives notice that it will hold a local public hearing on January 5, 2015, beginning at 6:00 p.m. at: Kimberling City Community Center, 34 Kimberling Blvd., Kimberling City, Missouri 65686. Staff shall hold a question-and-answer session before the Commission receives testimony.

2. Customers wishing to make written comments or secure additional information may contact the Office of the Public Counsel, Post Office Box 2230, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, telephone (573) 751-4857. Comments may also be registered in this case using the Internet Electronic Filing System at [psc.mo.gov](http://psc.mo.gov). Use the link to the Public Comment section and fill in all required fields on the comment page.

3. The local public hearing shall be held in a facility that meets the accessibility requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. Any person who needs additional accommodation to participate in the hearing should call the Public Service Commission's Hotline at 1-800-392-4211 (voice) or Relay Missouri at 711 prior to the hearing.

4. The Data Center of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall serve a copy of this order upon the County Commission of Stone County, Missouri.

5. The Public Information Office of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall make notice of this order available to members of the General Assembly representing Stone County, Missouri, and to the news media serving the residents of Stone County, Missouri.

6. This order shall be effective when issued.
