On February 23, 2021, Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC), on behalf of all the parties, filed a motion requesting to suspend the procedural schedule. MAWC related that the parties had reached a global settlement in principle and wished to have the procedural schedule suspended while they put the terms in writing and filed it with the Commission. The Commission granted the request and directed the parties file either their agreement or a status report no later than February 26, 2021.

On February 26, 2021, MAWC, on behalf of all the parties, filed a status report indicating that the parties have a draft agreement and are still working to finalize the attachments to that agreement. The parties indicate they will be ready to file the agreement or an additional status report by March 3, 2021. The Commission will direct the further status report or the agreement be filed on that date.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The parties are directed to file a stipulation and agreement resolving the contested issues or a status report no later than March 3, 2021.

2. This order shall become effective when issued.
