**ORDER SCHEDULING LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING  
AND DIRECTING NOTICE**

On April 4, 2023, Raytown Water Company (the Company) filed a letter requesting an increase in its annual overall operating revenues in a staff assisted rate case. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-10.075(6) requires a local public hearing to be scheduled to occur no later than 60 days after the opening of the case, unless all parties agree that a local public hearing is not necessary. The Commission will schedule a local public hearing in compliance with the Commission Rule. The Commission will hold the hearing via video and telephone conference, and will direct written comments to be submitted to the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System (EFIS).

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. A public hearing is scheduled to begin at **6 p.m.** on **May 23, 2023**, via the internet-based video and teleconferencing service, WebEx. At the time of the hearing dial 1-855-718-6621 and enter the Access Code/Password

2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make an informal presentation and conduct a question-and-answer session for the public at the beginning of the local public hearing. Comments to the Commission from the public will begin at the conclusion of the question and answer session.

3. The Company, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, and the Office of the Public Counsel shall make a representative available to address substantive issues during the question-and-answer sessions. Any other party may also choose to have a representative present.

4. No later than ten days before the local public hearing, the Company shall provide notice of the hearing to each of its customers.

5. Any person may comment at the hearing. To facilitate an orderly presentation that can be preserved for the record, members of the public who wish to participate in the hearing shall register by sending their first and last name, phone number, and email address to [watersewercomments@psc.mo.gov](mailto:watersewercomments@psc.mo.gov), or by calling (800) 392-4211 no later than 5:00 p.m. the day before the hearing, May 22, 2023.

6. A live audio web stream at the Commission's website, [www.psc.mo.gov](http://www.psc.mo.gov), will provide audio of the hearing. Those who do not intend to participate in the hearing should listen via the web stream.
