- MR. WOODRUFF: We're on the record.
- 3 We're here for a local public hearing in Case No.
- 4 WR-2004-0450 which concerns Taney County Utilities
- 5 Corporation's request for a small water and sewer
- 6 company rate increase. We're here at Reeds Spring,
- 7 at the high school, and the notice in this case
- 8 indicated the hearing would begin at 6:30; by the
- 9 clock on the wall, it is now 6:40 and we don't have
- 10 any customers here at the moment. Let's go ahead
- 11 and take entries of appearance from the legal
- 12 counsel. Is there someone there from staff?
- 13 MR. KRUEGER: Keith Krueger here for
- 14 staff, Missouri Public Service Commission. My
- 15 address is P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri
- 16 65102.
- 17 MR. WOODRUFF: And for the Office of
- 18 Public Counsel down here in Reeds Spring?
- MS. O'NEILL: Ruth O'Neill for the
- 20 Office of the Public Counsel. My address is P.O.
- 21 Box 2230, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.
- MR. WOODRUFF: We have three
- 23 commissioners with us this evening appearing from
- 24 Jefferson City: Chairman Steve Gaw, Commissioner
- 25 Connie Murray, Commissioner Robert Clayton. All

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1 right. We also have four representatives of the
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- 2 company with us here this evening. Do you want to
- 3 go ahead and tell us your names.
- 4 MR. SCOTT: Richard Scott.
- 5 MS. POPE: Tammy Pope.
- 6 MS. PICKREN: Honey Pickren.
- 7 MR. PICKREN: Rick Pickren.
- 8 MR. WOODRUFF: Thank you, sir. We have
- 9 one representative of staff here.
- 10 MR. NICKEL: Bill Nickel.
- 11 MR. WOODRUFF: And as I indicated
- 12 before, we do not have any customers. Ms. O'Neill,
- 13 is there anything you want to put on the record?
- MS. O'NEILL: Your Honor, I have
- 15 received several letters and several phone calls in
- 16 response to the second customer notice that went out
- 17 regarding the proposed rate increase. I invited the
- 18 people who contacted us by phone to appear at the
- 19 local public hearing if they wanted to make a
- 20 statement to the commission in person. Nobody that
- 21 I talked to on the phone is evidently here.
- 22 MR. WOODRUFF: Okay. I believe notice
- 23 was issued in this case.
- MS. O'NEILL: That's correct.
- MR. WOODRUFF: All right. Mr. Krueger,

- 1 is there anything you want to add for staff?
- 2 MR. KRUEGER: No, your Honor.
- 3 MR. WOODRUFF: Commissioner Gaw,
- 4 anything you want to put on the record?
- 5 MR. GAW: Just thanks, everyone, that
- 6 is here for showing up and we appreciate your help
- 7 and those of you who drove down there, we appreciate
- 8 it. You have a long trip back so be careful. And
- 9 this has been an interesting experiment. At least
- 10 we get to see the technology works so it's good to
- 11 know that for future reference. Thank you. Thank
- 12 you all very much, Judge, and we'll hope that we
- 13 we'll review the record on the information that was
- 14 submitted to public counsel and use that as our
- 15 input from the public. Thank you.
- MR. WOODRUFF: Commissioner Murray,
- 17 anything you wanted to add?
- 18 MS. MURRAY: How many letters did you
- 19 receive, Ms. O'Neill?
- 20 MS. O'NEILL: I think I received --
- 21 actually, as I look through here, I've got my file
- 22 of the first set of letters and I don't know if I
- 23 have a complete set of the other letters. I think I
- 24 received about three letters and about five phone
- 25 calls.

- 1 MS. MURRAY: Were they all in
- 2 opposition to the rate increase?
- 3 MS. O'NEILL: They were all in
- 4 opposition to the rate increase, yes. I did receive
- 5 a number of additional letters at the time of the
- 6 first notice, but I did not receive nearly as many
- 7 letters the second time out, once the proposed
- 8 agreement with the staff and the company was entered
- 9 into.
- 10 MR. WOODRUFF: The first notice would
- 11 have been about a year ago?
- MS. O'NEILL: The first was about a
- 13 year ago. I received several at that time. At this
- 14 time, I think there have been about five phone calls
- 15 and about three letters.
- MS. MURRAY: Were there any service
- 17 quality issues raised?
- MS. O'NEILL: The only service quality
- 19 issue that was raised is I had one phone call
- 20 complaining about the smell that came from the
- 21 water. And I think that as far as this second
- 22 round, that's the only service quality issue that I
- 23 have.
- 24 MS. MURRAY: Thank you. I would like
- 25 to reiterate what the Chairman said. We appreciate

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1 everybody that made the long trip to be there for
2 the public hearing. Also glad our technology works.
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- 3 MR. WOODRUFF: Yes. Commissioner
- 4 Clayton, anything?
- 5 MR. CLAYTON: It's an honor to take
- 6 part in this making a little bit of history here,
- 7 just showing that the Missouri Public Service
- 8 Commission is on the cutting edge of technology in
- 9 bringing its message to the people of this state. I
- 10 would like to thank Daniel for putting together this
- 11 presentation and hopefully giving us the opportunity
- 12 to spread this technology around the state in other
- 13 hearings. Thank you, Daniel, for all you do.
- MR. WOODRUFF: Anything else anybody
- 15 wants to add?
- 16 (No response.)
- MR. WOODRUFF: With that we are
- 18 adjourned. Thank you all.
