Staff filed its proposal in response to the proposal of Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC").³ MAWC filed a reply stating that it has no objection to Staff's proposal. The Office of the Public Counsel is also a party to this action,⁴ but has exercised its option to file no pleading as to the merits of this action so far.

Any position statement shall set forth any relief requested, cite any legal authority supporting that relief, and allege facts relevant under that authority with citations to any pre-filed testimony in support. Briefs shall include separately stated proposed findings of fact with citations to the record.

The Commission will issue notice of contested case and notice of hearing separately.
