## ORDER SETTING PARTIAL PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On June 23, 2022, the parties filed a Proposed Procedural Schedule. The Commission is unavailable for hearing on the parties' suggested hearing date of August 2, so the Commission will await further suggested hearing dates from the parties.<sup>1</sup> The Commission will set the date for the filing of direct testimony at the time requested by the parties. The rest of the procedural schedule will not be set at this time to allow the parties flexibility in constructing a complete schedule.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following partial procedural schedule is established:  
Direct Testimony - July 8, 2022
2. The transcripts of the evidentiary hearing shall be expedited.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.

<sup>1</sup> By statute, the Commission must issue an order with an effective date of no later than August 31. Thus, to allow time for briefing and consideration by the Commission, any hearing should occur in July. If the parties cannot find a July hearing date, the Commission encourages parties to consider alternative arrangements such as submitting their cases on prefiled testimony without cross-examination or scheduling more than one partial day of hearings to accommodate witness availability.
