**ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION**

On November 4, 2014, Kimberling City Water Company (“KCWC”) asked that the Commission approve its agreement with the Upper White River Basin Foundation, Inc., (“UWRB”). That agreement would allow KCWC to sell its assets to UWRB.

On November 25, 2014, the Commission received a timely intervention request from the Missouri Department of Natural Resources. No party objected.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4) allows the Commission to grant intervention to a person who has an interest different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or if granting intervention would serve the public interest. Upon review of the unopposed application, the Commission finds that the applicant meets the standard in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4). Therefore, the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The applications to intervene filed by The Missouri Department of Natural Resources is granted.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
