STAFF RESPONSE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through Staff Counsel's Office, and states as follows:

- 1. On November 25, 2019, the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC") filed its *Motion to Open a Working Group Docket Regarding a Proposed Residential Customer Disconnection Data Reporting Rule* ("Motion") that contained a proposed procedural schedule and included a draft proposed rule, memorandum, and other supporting documents. The Commission directed Staff, in its November 26 Order, to respond to OPC's Motion and provide a recommendation on whether the proposed procedural schedule is appropriate.
- 2. Staff has reviewed OPC's Motion and incorporated documents and recommends the Commission consider, in this working docket, promulgation of a rule to standardize the residential disconnection of services reporting requirements of investor owned utilities subject to Commission jurisdiction. In order to give all stakeholders, including Staff, sufficient time to research best practices and provide thoughtful feedback on the draft rule OPC filed, Staff recommends the following dates as an alternative to the proposed procedural schedule in OPC's Motion:
 - February 14, 2020: Deadline for stakeholders to file comments in EFIS

- March 26, 2020: Workshop in Room 470 of the Governor Office
 Building¹
- May 2020: Decision on whether to move forward in the formal rulemaking process

WHEREFORE, Staff files this Staff Response to OPC's Motion for the Commission's consideration.
