2 JUDGE HATCHER: Let's go on the record. Today
3 is November 5, 2019. The Missouri Public Service
4 Commission has set this time for a local public hearing
5 in Case No. WR-2020-0053, and that also includes sewer
6 case SR-2020-0054, which is captioned as In The Matter
7 Of Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company, Inc.'s
8 Request For A Water Rate Increase.

9 The Commission has scheduled this local public
10 hearing to give members of the public a chance to
11 comment about Confluence Rivers Utility's application.
12 My name is Charles Hatcher, and I am the Regulatory Law
13 Judge and will preside over this hearing.

14 With me today are Commission Chairman Ryan
15 Silvey and Commissioner Maida Coleman. Let the record
16 reflect that no citizens have come forward to
17 participate in the hearing either for the presentation
18 and question and answer phase or for the hearing itself.

19 I'll go ahead and make a call to see if anyone
20 would like to testify. Is there anyone who would like
21 to testify at today's hearing? I see no hands and no
22 one coming forward. I'd like to ask counsel to
23 introduce themselves for the record and then I'm going
24 to see if anyone thinks that I'm forgetting anything.

2 MR. MITTEN: Judge Hatcher, let the record
3 reflect the appearance of Russ Mitten on behalf of
4 Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company. I've given
5 the court reporter my contact information.

8 MS. PAYNE: Whitney Payne on behalf of the
9 Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission. I too
10 have provided my information to the court reporter.

13 MR. CLIZER: John Clizer on behalf of the
14 Office of the Public Counsel. I have supplied my
15 information with the court reporter as well.

16 JUDGE HATCHER: Okay. I gave you all fair
17 warning in the last 30 seconds we're about to close the
18 hearing. Is there any other items of business that
19 anyone believes I need to accomplish before we close the
20 record? Thank you all for attending. This hearing is
21 adjourned. We are off the record.
