PROTECTIVE ORDER

Issue Date: January 17, 2023 Effective Date: January 17, 2023 On January 16, 2023, Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) filed a motion for a protective order. MAWC states that due to the nature of certain material regarding certain financial matters that are competitively sensitive, the "confidential" designation under Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.135 may not provide adequate protection

MAWC requests to have a protective order in place that would allow it to designate certain information as "Highly Confidential." MAWC states that no party objects to its motion. The Commission finds the request for a protective order reasonable and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The motion for protective order is granted.

2. Materials and information divulged by MAWC or other parties shall be considered to be "Highly Confidential" if so designated at the time of disclosure.

3. With regard to entities and individuals other than the Staff of the Commission, and the Office of the Public Counsel:

a. Disclosure of materials or information so designated shall be made only to attorneys and/or to such outside consultants who have executed a Commission Nondisclosure Agreement. No Highly Confidential information shall be provided directly or indirectly to any non-attorney individual or employee.

b. Persons afforded access to materials or information designated "Highly Confidential" shall neither use nor disclose such materials or information for purposes of business or competition or any other purpose other than in regard to the case referenced above and shall keep the materials and information secure and confidential and in accordance with the purposes and intent of the protective order.

c. All material and information designated as "Highly Confidential" in the possession of any entity or person, as well as any notes pertaining to such information, shall be returned to MAWC or destroyed upon the conclusion of the referenced case.

4. If a party disagrees with the "Highly Confidential" designation of any information, the party shall follow the informal discovery dispute resolution procedures set forth in Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.090(8). If the party exhausts these dispute resolution procedures, the party may file a motion challenging the designation.

5. This order shall be effective when issued.
