ORDER RESCHEDULING DISCOVERY CONFERENCE

Effective Date: June 23, 2023

On April 25, 2023,¹ the Commission issued its *Order Granting Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule* (Order). The Order sets July 5, as the next occurring pre-scheduled discovery conference, followed by another pre-scheduled discovery conference on July 19 and pre-filed surrebuttal testimony on July 21. Due to its scheduling needs, the Commission must move the July 5 pre-scheduled discovery conference forward one week to July 12.

At this time, the Commission will keep the remaining schedule unchanged, specifically the July 19 discovery conference and July 21 surrebuttal testimony due date. The parties are free to file requests to alter these dates.

Likewise, the Commission's change of the July 5 pre-scheduled discovery conference to July 12 does not preclude any party with more urgent discovery issues to seek redress sooner than July 12 pursuant to the procedures set forth in Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.090(8).

The Commission will also change the start time of the July 12 discovery conference to 9:00 a.m.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The procedural schedule ordered by the Commission on April 25 is changed to move the date of the next pre-scheduled discovery conference from July 5 to July 12. The remainder of the procedural schedule is unchanged.

2. The July 12 pre-scheduled discovery conference will begin at 9:00 a.m. WebEx information will be emailed to the parties. An electronic calendar cancellation of the July 5 WebEx will also be emailed to the parties.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
