- 2 JUDGE DANIEL JORDON: Public Service
- 3 Commission is calling File Number WR-2010-0131.
- 4 This is in regard to application for Missouri
- 5 American Water Company for rate increase.
- 6 My name is Daniel Jordon. I'm the
- 7 Regulatory Law Judge, assigned to this case. With
- 8 me this evening is Commissioner Robert Kenney. We
- 9 are here to take testimony from the public in regard
- 10 to the pending rate increase.
- 11 You will know that this hearing includes a
- 12 court reporter, which means we are on the record, so
- 13 if you would like to say something on the record,
- 14 you certainly may. The way you can do that is to
- 15 come forward to the podium, I will administer an
- oath and then you can tell the Commission what you
- 17 would like to say.
- 18 Why an oath? Well, a couple reasons.
- 19 One, we want you to be serious about things you have
- 20 to say. But also it may make it easier for anything
- 21 that is said in terms of someone to get what is said
- 22 on the record.
- Well, we've already had the opportunity to
- 24 speak with staff, so I will get right ahead into the
- 25 entries of the appearance. We will begin with the

- 1 applicant, Missouri America Water.
- 2 MR. REICHART: Thank you, Judge.
- 3 Appearing on behalf of Missouri American Water
- 4 Company, John J. Reichart. My address 727 Craig
- 5 Road, St. Louis, Missouri, 63141.
- 6 JUDGE DANIEL JORDON: Thank you. And for
- 7 the staff and Commission?
- 8 MS. BRUEGGEMANN: Thank you, Judge. My
- 9 name is Shelley Brueggemann. I'm here appearing
- 10 with staff. Our address is 200 Madison Street,
- 11 Jefferson City Missouri 65102.
- 12 JUDGE DANIEL JORDON: Thank you. And from
- 13 the Office of Public Counsel.
- 14 MR. MILLS: On behalf of the Office of
- 15 Public Counsel, my name is Lewis Mills. My address
- 16 is Post Office Box 2230, Jefferson City, Missouri
- 17 65102.
- 18 JUDGE DANIEL JORDON: Thank you. Well, as
- 19 I've said, I don't have anyone signed up to give
- 20 testimony, but if someone would like to testify,
- 21 someone would like to make a statement on the
- 22 record, now would be the time to do it.
- 23 Would anyone like to come forward and
- 24 testify? Please come forward and be sworn. Please
- 25 raise your right hand.

- JUDGE DANIEL JORDON: Please state your
- 3 name.
- 4 MR. BEXTERMUELLER: Nicholas Bextermueller,
- B-E-X-T-E-R-M-U-E-L-L-E-R.
- 6 JUDGE DANIEL JORDON: Are you a customer of
- 7 Missouri American Water?
- 8 MR. BEXTERMUELLER: Yes, I am.
- 9 JUDGE DANIEL JORDON: And, what would you
- 10 like the Commission to know?
- MR. BEXTERMUELLER: I showed up tonight in
- 12 concern with the rate increase always ending up on
- 13 the service side versus the volume side, because I
- 14 can't conserve water and still save on my bill. Six
- dollars of my bill is in water and \$20 of my bill is
- in service and, if you then throw another \$6 in
- 17 there. So my concern is can we get it to the
- 18 service side that that can help reduce my cost
- 19 should I end up in financial trouble. So if someone
- 20 could look into that a little bit harder, it might
- 21 be good, because this is the third increase in three
- 22 years on the side that I can't control. That's it.
- JUDGE DANIEL JORDON: Anything else you
- 24 would like to tell the Commission?
- MR. BEXTERMUELLER: No, sir.

- 1 COMMISSIONER ROBERT KENNEY: Mr.
- 2 Bextermueller, thank you for coming out tonight.
- 3 Do you have any issues with the quality of service
- 4 that you have received?
- 5 MR. BEXTERMUELLER: No, sir.
- 6 COMMISSIONER ROBERT KENNEY: Have you had
- 7 any occasions to have service calls or called the
- 8 company for inservice-related issues?
- 9 MR. BEXTERMUELLER: No, sir.
- 10 COMMISSIONER ROBERT KENNEY: I don't have
- 11 any other questions other than that. I will say
- 12 thank you again for coming and participating in the
- 13 process. I'm one of the Commissioners, but there
- 14 are five of us and there will be a transcript made
- 15 of the testimony that you've given tonight and the
- 16 other Commissioners will have an opportunity to take
- 17 your comments into consideration when we deliberate
- 18 in the rate case itself. So it is important that
- 19 you come out and provide your perspective and
- 20 provide your testimony on the record because it will
- 21 be taken into account. So thank you for
- 22 participating in the process and thank you for
- 23 coming out.
- 24 MR. BEXTERMUELLER: Appreciate the
- 25 opportunity.

```

- 2 anyone else like to testify this evening? I don't
- 3 see anyone rush toward the podium. Oh, here comes
- 4 someone.
- 5 MS. GRAWEY: My name is Amy Grawey,
- 6 G-R-A-W-E-Y. I live at the same address.
- 7 JUDGE DANIEL JORDON: Please raise your
- 8 right hand as far as you are able.
- 9 (WITNESS IS SWORN)
- 10 JUDGE DANIEL JORDON: You are also a
- 11 customer of Missouri American Water?
- 12 MS. GRAWEY: I only raise the concern that I
- 13 don't have an option in my ability to choose a water
- 14 service provider. I have been very happy with my
- 15 service from Missouri American Water. I like the
- 16 quality. They e-mail me if they have to, and I
- 17 appreciate that.
- 18 We do have in our area one of the best
- 19 waters in the country. So I do appreciate that, but
- 20 with the continual rate increases, it makes me
- 21 consider going to another provider and I don't have
- 22 that option. So that is one of the things that is
- 23 troublesome to me when I get notices that the rate
- 24 increases and I don't have an option to go to
- 25 another provider. That's the only other concern I

1 have. 2 JUDGE DANIEL JORDON: Thank you. I have no 3 questions for you. COMMISSIONER ROBERT KENNEY: No questions, 5 but thank you for taking the time to come and share 6 your thoughts with us. 7 THE WITNESS: Thank you. 8 JUDGE DANIEL JORDON: I neglected to ask 9 whether there were any questions from the other parties. I'm seeing shaking heads from the staff 10 11 from public counsel. No questions of either of you. 12 Well, is there anyone else here that would like to testify? I am seeing only one person. 13 14 I thank everyone for being here this 15 evening and, since there is no more testimony, no more cross-examination of the witnesses, I will 16 17 adjourn this hearing and we will go off the record. 18 Thank you. 19 20 21 22
