On September 15, 2005, a proposed rule, 4 CSR 240-33.045, was published in the *Missouri Register*. The Order of Rulemaking was published in the *Code of State Regulations* on September 30, 2005 and the rule became effective on October 30, 2005.

Section 536.200.2, RSMo 2000 requires that certain information be published in the *Missouri Register* if, after the first full year of implementation, the actual cost of the rule has exceeded the estimated cost. On July 24, 2007, the Staff of the Commission filed a pleading informing the Commission that the estimated cost of the rule was accurate obviating the need to have published cost information in the *Missouri Register*.

Although this matter was closed on November 1, 2005, Staff's filing reopened the case. There now remains no further action by the Commission. This case may therefore be again closed.
